Kills fleas and ticks on dogs and cats and in other areas where fleas and ticks hide. Repels mosquitoes, flies and gnats, too!

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE CAN WELL BEFORE USING. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

To Kill Fleas & Ticks on Dogs and Cats: Apply directly to animals along back, under forelegs, and other areas except scrotum and anus. Part hair to contact skin and insure good coverage. Hold nozzle about one foot away while spraying. Apply until hair is thoroughly moist. Do not spray directly in eyes or mouth of animal. Repeat if necessary. (Note: This aerosol may make a slight hissing sound and cause a temporary cool sensation.) Hold pet securely while applying. Nervous animals may become frightened the first time this product is used but soon become accustomed to the treatment. Do not treat or cause exposure to kittens or puppies under eight weeks of age. Do not use on pregnant dogs.

To Kill Fleas & Ticks in Pet Bedding and Pet Areas: To reduce reinfestation, thoroughly spray the animal's bedding and other resting places until the surface is slightly moist. Treat these areas at the rate of two seconds per linear foot at a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Also spray entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary.

To Treat Flea & Tick Infestation in Rugs and Carpets: Spray rugs and carpets where fleas tend to hide. If used on light or delicate upholstery fabrics, test for potential staining in an inconspicuous place prior to use. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, in walls and floors, along baseboards, windows and door frames. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE: Store in original container in areas inaccessible to small children.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.

CAUTION: Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Cover or remove exposed foods. Avoid contamination of cooking utensils and food preparation surfaces. Cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not use on edible crops.
