In the meantime, EPA is approving new registrations and amendments to existing registrations of rodenticide bait products, on a time-limited basis, so long as the registrations do not present greater risks of unreasonable adverse effects than existing products. Accordingly, this registration is approved only subject to the condition that the registration shall expire on June 4, 2011. This condition of registration may be amended in conjunction with amendments to conform to the Risk Mitigation Decision. Absent such amendments, product released for shipment by the registrant after June 4, 2011, would be in violation of FIFRA.
- 6. Submit one copy of the revised final printed label for the record before you release the product for shipment.

- 1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.
- 2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by children under six years of age and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hoofed livestock, raccoons, bears, other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.

#### **USE RESTRICTIONS:**

This product may only be used to control Norway Rats, Roof Rats and house mice only in the sites identified below.

- In URBAN AREAS, this product may only be used in homes, industrial, commercial and public buildings; and in transport vehicles (ships, trains, aircraft) and in related port or terminal buildings.
- In **NON-URBAN AREAS**, this product may only be used inside of homes and agricultural buildings. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Do not broadcast bait.

**SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS:** Determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or signs of rodents have been seen. Remove as much alternative food as possible. Use tamper-resistant bait stations wherever necessary (see "IMPORTANT:").

Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days or until signs of rat activity ceases.

(For Rats and Mice) Check bait locations every 2 days for signs of feeding. Replenish bait if more than 1/2 of the original amount has been removed by rodents. Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately if rodent activity is still evident. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish as needed.
