TREATMENT FOR PET POISONING

If animal eats bait, call veterinarian at once.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN OR VETERINARIAN

Contains the nerve poison Bromethalin. This is not an anticoagulant type rodenticide. For humans or animals ingesting bait and/or showing poisoning signs (such as muscle tremors, loss of hind limb use, or seizures for animals), limit absorption by either emesis or gastric lavage. Sublethal symptoms, if present, would be the result of cerebral edema and should be treated accordingly through administration of an osmotic diuretic and corticosteroid.

- d. Revise the marketing statement "Attack mouse problems (now)" to state "Attack house mouse problems (now)."
- e. Revise the marketing statement "Ideal for mice populations" to state "Ideal for house mouse populations."
- f. Since this is not the actual brand name of the product, do not include "Mimas II (Bromethalin)" on the label.
- 3. Storage stability (830.6317) and corrosion characteristics (830.6320) data must be submitted within 18 months of the date of this notice.
- 4. Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.
- 5. This registration is not consistent with the Agency's revised May 28, 2008, "Risk Mitigation Decision for Ten Rodenticides." EPA anticipates cancellation of those existing products that are not consistent with the Risk Mitigation Decision to occur no later than June 4, 2011. In the meantime, EPA is approving new registrations and amendments to existing registrations of rodenticide bait products, on a time-limited basis, so long as the registrations do not present greater risks of unreasonable adverse effects than existing products. Accordingly, this registration is approved only subject to the condition that the registration shall expire on June 4, 2011. This condition of registration may be amended in conjunction with amendments to conform to the Risk Mitigation Decision. Absent such amendments, product released for shipment by the registrant after June 4, 2011, would be in violation of FIFRA.
