RATS-N-MICE BAIT

HOW TO USE FOR RATS: Simply slit along perforations with knife or fingernail and set out. Examine baits regularly and replace as needed.

HOW TO USE FOR MICE: Same as for rats except that bait should be placed in more places and more frequently. Bait should be replaced as long as there is evidence of feeding.

CAUTION: Staffek's Rats-N-Mice Bait contains a potent coumaphenol chemical which, if taken, may cause death in humans and animals. May reduce the clotting ability of the blood.
