Make one or more applications as needed. Use 6 pounds Malathion 25% wettable Powder per 100 gallons of water for control of Soft Brown Scale, Monterrey Pine Scale and Black Scale Crawlers. Make one or more applications as needed. Use 6 pounds Malathion 25% Wettable Powder per 100 gallons of water for control of Juniper Scale, Fletcher Scale, Bagworms, Oak Kermes, Florida Red Scale, Azalea Scale, Magnolia Scale, Pine Leaf Scale, Tent Caterpillar, Birch Leaf Miner and Boxwood Leaf Miner. Make one or more applications as needed after crawlers have settled on the foliage.

NOTE: Make thorough full coverage sprays. Repeat application as needed. Do not use on Boston, Maidenhair, Pteris Ferns or species of Crassula. Do not apply on Petunias.

Chicken Red Mites and Northern Fowl Mite in Poultry Houses: Apply 2½ oz. of 25% MALATHION WETTABLE per gal. per 100 to 150 birds. Repeat application in 4 to 8 weeks or when necessary. Do not apply Malathion directly to birds. Avoid contamination of food and water troughs.


