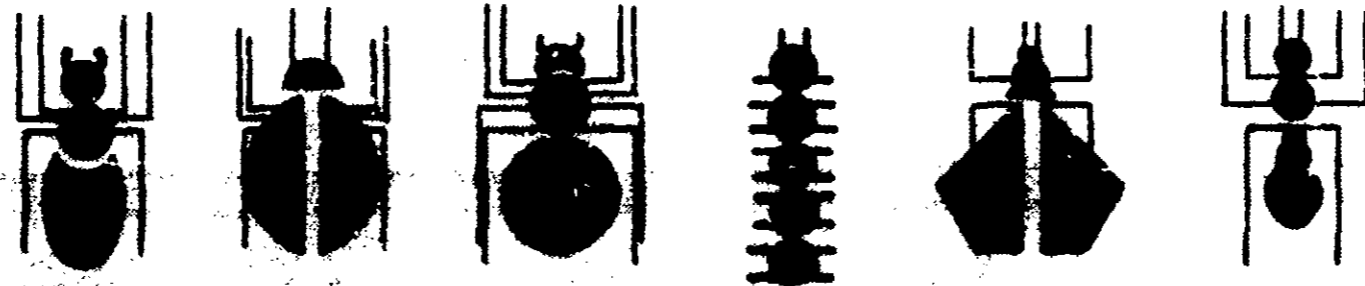

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Shake well before each use. Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. A well-ventilated room should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

CONTROL HOUSEHOLD PESTS

For Houseflies, Mosquitoes and Gnats - Use in rooms and windows where the insects are most likely to be found. Spray directly at the insects. Use a low pressure spray. For flying insects, spray directly at the insects. For crawling insects, spray directly on the insects. Repeat as necessary to obtain control.

Ants - Spray directly on the ants. Repeat as necessary to obtain control.

OUTDOORS - TO REDUCE ANNOYANCE FROM FLYING INSECTS

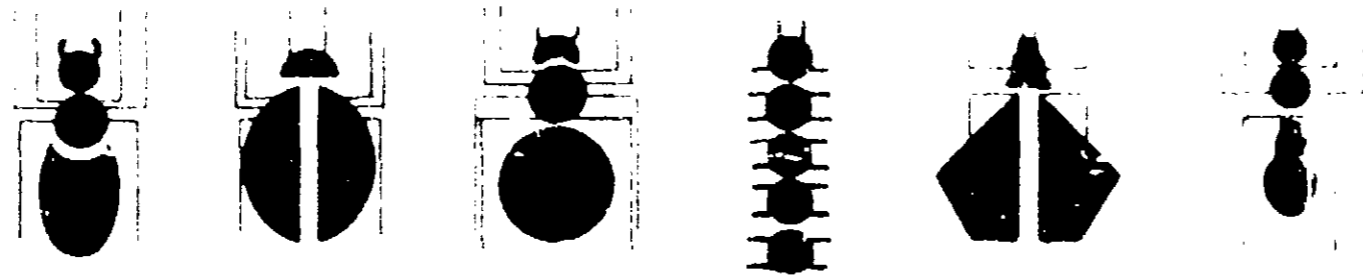
Use in open areas where flying insects are a nuisance. Spray directly at the insects. Use a low pressure spray. For flying insects, spray directly at the insects. For crawling insects, spray directly on the insects. Repeat as necessary to obtain control.

OUTDOORS - TO PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS

To control aphids, exposed thrips, adult white flies, leafhoppers, two-spotted mites, plant bugs, spittlebugs and Japanese beetles on smaller rhododendrons, pines, spruce, hemlock, spirea, dogwood, palm, mimosa, toyon, viburnum, euonymus, oaks, maples, locust, forsythia and althea; and mimosa webworm larvae on mimosa, spray directly on insects. Hold container 18 inches from the infested plants. Spray in short spray bursts of one to three seconds or spray at the rate of one linear foot of growth per second. Direct spray to all sides covering foliage until slightly moist. Avoid heavy wetting. Repeat as necessary to obtain control.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

DO DOORS TO PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS

Spray peonies, iris, zinnia, snapdragons, ageratum, chrysanthemums, nasturtiums, daisy, geraniums, marigolds, daphne, fishederz, ivy, tobira, queen wago and broad leaf acacia for control of aphids, exposed thrips, adult white flies, leafhoppers, plant bugs, spittlebugs and Japanese beetles. Spray as directed above.

USE WITH CAUTION on azaleas, junipers, roses, including hybrid tea roses, flowering quince, oak and camellias. These plants may be subject to leaf or flower burn under certain conditions of use.

For adult whiteflies, two spotted mites and mealybugs, be sure to direct spray to contact these pests. Thoroughly cover the infested area. Use several repeat applications at two day intervals if necessary.

PROTECT HOUSE PLANTS:

Spray indoor house plants: Begonias, geraniums, begonias, cacti for listed pests. Leave the treated area when done indoors, and ventilate area after treatment is completed.

HOUSE PESTS — ON OR ENTERING BUILDINGS:

Blow application should be made to the cracks when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, such as under floorboards as possible. Repeat as necessary. Some insects on their way to their lairings.

Apply to the base of trees and plants in yard. Kill or ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Warning: Do not spray directly on plants and repeat as necessary.

Warning: Do not spray directly on plants in crevices, etc. Do not place on outdoor porches, patios and other structures.

HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED. Do not use on lawns and rooftops. Remove birds, pets and cover aquariums before spraying. Do not use on edible crops.
