

The 15 gallon canister can treat an undisturbed area up to 12,000 cubic feet (20' x 40' x 15' ceiling). DO NOT USE IN AN AREA SMALLER THAN 1,000 CUBIC FEET (15' x 20' x 10' ceiling). For smaller rooms, use 6-ounce 1.5 ounce can. Treats rooms up to 6,000 cubic feet (20' x 30' x 15' ceiling).

PREPARATION

REMOVE artwork, toys, wax-covered floors and waxed furniture which may be damaged with use of disinfectant. (Disinfectant may be used.)

Remove papers, clothes, trunks and other items in area to be treated.

REMOVE pet and cover or remove fish tanks and bowls; remove or cover plants, insects, plants and articles made of cotton, terrycloth.

CLOSE outside doors and windows; turn off fans and air conditioners. Turn on all open flames except pilot lights.

DIRECTING

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.

1. Set can on a raised spot, such as a table, chair or stand at least 100 feet from pilot light. Spread paper under can to cover area directly beneath can. Remove cover.

2. Tilt top of can away from floor.

3. Press lever down firmly until it clicks.

4. Set can upright on paper...

5. Stand leave the room closing the door behind you.

6. After 4 hours, turn can closed for 4 hours.

7. After 4 hours, open all doors and windows, turn on air conditioners and fans, and let the treated area air for 30 minutes.

Repeat treatment in two weeks or as necessary.

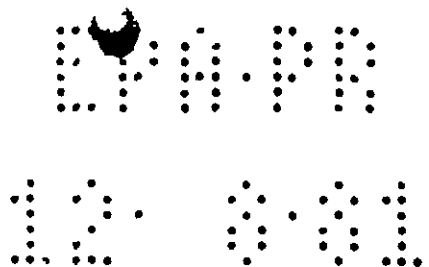

GENERAL DIRECTIONS

Shake well before each use. Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

CONTROL HOUSEHOLD PESTS:

For Houseflies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats: Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward, direct spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

For Crawling Insects: Roaches, earwigs, grasshoppers, sowbugs, spiders and centipedes. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible.

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Animal Pests: Dogs, Cats — Fleas. Apply directly to animals along back under forelegs and on other areas. Part hair to contact skin and insure good coverage. Hold nozzle about one foot away while spraying. Apply until hair is thoroughly moist. Do not directly spray into eyes, ears or mouth of animal. To reduce reinfestation thoroughly spray the animal's bedding and other resting areas. Treat these areas at the rate of two seconds per linear foot while spraying at a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Also spray entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS — TO REDUCE ANNOYANCE FROM FLYING INSECTS:

Reduce mosquitoes, gnats, midges, houseflies, biting flies and pyralid and noctuid flying moths by spraying their resting areas. Follow precautions listed above. Hold container 18 to 24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of from 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the insects start to fly. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.
