IMPORTED FIRE ANT & ANT MOUND TREATMENT IN ORNAMENTAL AND VEGETABLE GARDENS AND PLANTINGS - This product may be used for the treatment of Imported Fire Ant mounds found in and around plantings of Roses, Asters, Dahlias, Azaleas, Euonymous, Hydrangeas, Junipers, Lilacs, and vegetables such as Tomatoes, Peppers, Eggplants, Potatoes, Cucumbers, Squash, Melons, Beans, and Sweet Corn. HOW TO APPLY: Apply when air is calm in early morning or evening. Hold Aerosol 18 to 24 inches from the center of the mound. Direct nozzle toward the center and spray with a slow circular motion to allow the spray to gently settle over the mound area and out around to a diameter of 3 to 4 feet. Allow approximately 3 to 4 seconds of aerosol spray per treatment. Contact as many insects directly with the spray as possible. Repeat treatment as needed for control.
