#### Hazards To Humans and Domestic Animals

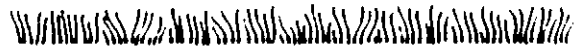

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

In accordance with Federal law to use this product in a manner consistent with its labeling.

**How To Use This Product** - This product is Ready To Use. Apply with the "Sprinkler" applicator cap. Simply invert the jug and sprinkle liquid herbicide over the undesirable weeds. Thoroughly wet leaves and stem surfaces.

**Where To Use** - The product is designed to stop weed growth along lawn borders, under fences, along sidewalk, buildings, drainage ditches, lumber yards, filling dirt on power plants, around the base of fireplugs, guy wires, light poles, on gravel driveways, patios, and playgrounds where there are weeds that might breed insects, or pose a fire hazard or cause unsightly areas around dwellings, utility buildings, or vacant lots.

**How Much To Use** - One gallon will treat approximately 300 sq. ft. of weedy area (15' x 20'). Spot treatment will conserve material when treating weeds growing through asphalt, concrete or gravelled areas. For treatment under fencing one gallon will treat a band 6 inches wide for 600 feet of fence or 12 inches wide for 300 feet.

**A Partial List Of Weedy Plants Killed With This Herbicide**  
**Grasses** - St. Augustine grass, Kill Fescue, Feeder's Ragwort, Bahia grass, Crabgrass, Barnyard grass, Ely grass, Foxtail, Quackgrass, Jimblewee, Buffalo grass, Cynchura, Sandbar.

**Broadleaf Weeds** - Buckhorn, Black Flamingo, Hairweed, White quarter, Poppy, pigweed, Pigweed, Fat Hen, Ragweed, Toad Weed, Crab, Redstem, Rock Medick, Carpetweed, Chickweed, Yellow Topweed, Bent, Spurge, Knotweed, Groundsage, Purple Topweed, Smartweed, Yellow Top, Yellow Topweed, Ivy, Topsoil, Eyebrow, Water, and Field Horsetail.
