Applications within Food Handling Establishments: Places where this product is used in which exposed food is held, prepared, packaged or stored including but not limited to areas for receiving, storing, preparing, handling, wrapping, displaying, preparing, holding, adding, mixing, storage and packaging, processing systems (pills, capsules, etc.), dispensing and serving areas, where food is prepared and held, in open areas, use as a crack and crevice treatment in and around back bars and use food areas for control areas: Cashiers, Cooks, Sauté, Sauté, and Waiters. Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices in partitions between different elements of construction between equipment and floor openings leading to walls and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases in cabinets, under heating pipes and so forth. Prior to application do a thorough cleaning of equipment. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or transferring the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food and food processing surfaces.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

APPLICATIONS WITHIN FOOD HANDLING AREAS: (Places where food is prepared, held, stored, etc., including areas where food may be prepared or held.) Apply in a spot treatment on various surfaces such as backbars, under elements of construction and into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. Do not apply where food is in operation or food is exposed.

DIRECTION FOR USE

It is a water-soluble product for use in a regular manner. See side panel for use.

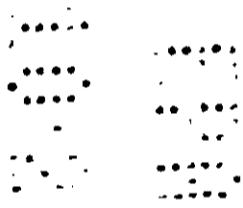
HOW TO MIX: This product is a concentrate and must be diluted. Mix one (1) 1/2 fluid ounce per quart of water (equal to 6.25 ounces per gallon of water). Follow directions for use and Caution Statements. Do not use more than is needed for one spraying. One quart dilute spray will cover approximately 2 1/2 sq. ft. of wall 10 ft. high or 1 gallon will cover 7.5 to 10.0 sq. ft. of area. Select a sprayer to deliver a coarse spray with the smallest amount of mist.

HOPE, APARTMENTS, GARAGES, HOMES, HOTELS, RESTAURANTS, FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS

To Kill Fleas, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Flies, Gnats, Lice, and Spiders: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment in areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners or rooms and closets, cracks and crevices, under carpets, along baseboards, and under sills and doors, behind and beneath walls, doors, refrigerators, and cupboards and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. First clean out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. Spray on walls, under and around doors.

To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Apply thoroughly as a spot treatment to selected areas such as pet beds, and resting quarters, and nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames, and behind areas of floor and base coverings where these pests may hide. First bedding should be placed in sealed plastic bags before use. Do not spray pets with this product.

To Control Fleas, Gnats, Mosquitoes, Phlebotomus, Small Flying Wasps, and Yellow Jackets: Use only on outdoor surfaces, spray on surfaces of window and door frames and other areas where they may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and behind wiring areas such as under stairs, porches, patios, and in garages where they may congregate. Fleas and Mosquitoes coming to rest on outdoor surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when infestation diminishes.

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.
