WHERE TO USE: The bait can be used in the following manner: Dispense through the applicator tip. It can be used as is for a bait placement or applied to a small 1 inch square piece of cardboard as a "Bait Station" and then placed in appropriate locations where ants have been seen and where they seem to congregate. It may be used in Food Storage, Processing & Serving Areas or in Bathrooms, Sleeping Rooms, Closets, and Food Disposal Areas in Homes, Restaurants, Hospitals, Apartments, Condominiums, Grocery Stores, Cafeterias, Warehouses & Storage Areas, and Food Processing Plants. DO NOT PLACE THE BAIT IN AREAS OR LOCATIONS ACCESSABLE TO CHILDREN OR PETS. Do not use on Marble or Limestone surfaces.



HOW OFTEN TO USE: "Bait cards" should be inspected weekly to make sure of effectiveness. Keep the bait out for at least several weeks and repeat at regular monthly intervals until ants are under control. If bait is dusty or dirty replace immediately with fresh bait and continue until Ant Control is accomplished.

OTHER INSECTS CONTROLLED - Roaches, Silverfish and Waterbugs that may feed upon this bait will also be controlled. For control; bait the area as for ANTS making several locations available to insects. Plan on keeping the bait out in the water for best control, replacing bait as needed.
