**DIRECTIONS:** For a complete list of uses, see the use of this product in a number of other uses on the label.

For use on flies, gnats, mosquitoes, crickets, cockroaches, ants, centipedes, spiders, fleas, and ticks.

**To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats:** Close all doors and windows and spray upward from center of room with a slow sweep motion. Spray 4 to 5 seconds for average room. Keep room closed 15 to 20 minutes after spray. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

**To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets:** Contact as many insects as possible with the spray, in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces, under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, and other areas where these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ticks, spray around windows and doors and other areas of entry. Kill if necessary.

**To Kill Centipedes and Spiders:** Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

**To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks:** Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Thoroughly spray pet quarters, pet bedding, newspapers, window and door cracks and floor areas. Repeat as necessary. Do not use on cats. Put fresh bedding in pet quarters after spray has dried. Wash dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product to prevent them from entering treated areas.

**Hazard:** Irritant to Eyes and Domestic Animals. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water.

**Precautions:** Use in a well-ventilated area. Preparation, storage and use instructions.
