IN THE LAUNDRY: Add 1/8 cup of bleach per each 2 gallons of water. Boiling is unnecessary. Mix well. Wash in usual way. DIRECTIONS

USE FOR WHITE AND FAST COLORS ONLY

IN THE LAUNDRY: Add $\frac{1}{8}$ cup of bleach per each 2 gallons of water. Boiling is unnecessary. Mix well. Wash in usual way. As a bleach add $\frac{1}{8}$ cup or 1 ounce per 2 gallons of water or 1 cup bleach per each washing machine load (16 gallon machine). Rinse in several waters before drying. In automatics, bleach should be added to suds water before clothing is placed in machine. If added while clothing is in suds, dilute with 1 quart of water before adding.

STAIN REMOVER: To remove scorch, ink, fruit, tea, coffee, grass, or other stains, add $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of bleach to quart of water. Mix well and allow to soak until stains disappear. Rinse thoroughly.

TO CLEANSE — DEODORIZE: For all surfaces in BATHROOM AND KITCHEN, to clean sinks, bathtubs, tile, linoleum, porcelain, use $\frac{1}{4}$ cup bleach per 1 gallon of water. Wash thoroughly with warm suds. Spread the solution with a cloth — let stand for 2 minutes and then rinse well. DO NOT use on silverware.

TOILET BOWLS: Use $\frac{1}{2}$ cup bleach. Pour in bleach and swab with brush — let stand for 10 minutes and then flush.

RESTAURANTS, TAVERNS, SODA FOUNTAINS, DAIRIES.

1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses;
2. Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner;
3. Rinse with clean water;
4. Sanitize in a solution of 1 ounce to 2 gals. of water (200 p.p.m.). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for a contact time specified by governing sanitary code.
5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to air dry.

IMPORTANT: Do not use chlorine bleach in combination with ammonia or other household chemicals, toilet bowl cleaners, and rust removers. Otherwise hazardous gases may be released.

CAUTION: WILL IRRITATE SKIN AND EYES. HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED.

Do not get on skin or in eyes. If splashed in eyes or on skin, flood with water, 15 minutes. If taken internally, give milk or bread soaked in milk followed by cooking oil. Call Physician.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN — NOT FOR PERSONAL USE

Do not use in copper, aluminum or iron vessels. Use in porcelain or enamel lined vessel. Avoid transfer to food or beverage containers.
