In our November 21, 1996, letter, we requested you to submit A) a revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) and B) a revised label for this product, within 30 days of receipt of our letter. With your December 9, 1996, letter, we have received a revised label, which has been reviewed below, but have not received a revised CSF. The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the following changes and submit one (1) copy to us before you ship your product:

1. As indicated in our last two letters regarding labeling, May 11, 1995, and November 21, 1996, after your Ingredient Statement, format the beginning of your Precautionary Statements as follows:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

CAUTION -

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful ... before reuse.

2. Since all of your precautionary statements are on the Front Panel, you do not need the heading "Precautionary Statements".

- 3. The heading, "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" needs to have the same left margin as "CAUTION" to conform to our standard labeling format. Following the standard format makes its easier for users, most of whom also use other pesticides, to find needed information on the label.
- 4. Change your registration number <u>from</u>:

"EPA Reg. No. 3342-01" to "EPA Reg. No. 3342-4".

5. Change your establishment number <u>from</u>:

"EPA Est. No. 3342-4" to "EPA Est. No. 3342-NC-01".

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
