## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

## AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:** Apply liberally on both sides of foliage with a hand duster at the rate of 15 to 30 pounds per acre, depending on the level of infestation and size of plants. Repeat as necessary to control insects.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Store only in original container in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
