STRAWBERRIES For aphids and red spider use 25-30 lbs. per acre repeating against red spider 7-10 days later. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.
TOBACCO SEED BEDS Parathion dust should be applied to seed beds with rotary hand dusters only. For the control of flea beetles and aphids use 3.4 to 17 lb. per 100 sq. yd. When flea beetles or Aphids first appear, dust plants uniformly early and severe infestations may require 2 or 3 treatments.
Seed Bed For the control of green and black grubs use 2 lb. per 100 sq. yd.
F.L.D. Parathion dust should be applied to the field by power dusting equipment only for the control of Aphids, scale flies and similar insects 10-15 lb. per acre. Apply dust thoroughly and repeat if necessary. Extreme caution in handling parathion. Do not store or grow potatoes near treated areas. Do not apply within 14 days of harvesting. Avoid plant injury from direct contact with the skin of those engaged in dusting the crop.

STRAWBERRIES: For aphids and red spider use 25-30 lbs. per acre repeating against red spider 7-10 days later. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

Tobacco Seed Beds: Parathion Dust should be applied to seed beds with rotary hand dusters only. For the control of Flea beetles and Aphids. Use 3.4 to 15 lb. per 100 sq. yd. When Flea beetles or Aphids first appear, dust plants uniformly, early and severe infestations may require 2 or 3 treatments.

Seed Bed: For the control of Green June beetle grubs use 2 lb. per 100 sq. yd.

FIELD: Parathion dust should be applied in the field by power dusting equipment only for the control of Aphids, suck flies and split worm use 10 to 25 lb. per acre. Apply dust thoroughly to all parts of plant. Repeat if necessary. Extreme caution in handling parathion. Do not store or grow potatoes near tobacco. Do not apply within 5 days of pruning or 15 days of cutting. Avoid plant juices coming in contact with the skin of those engaged in cutting or pruning the crop.
