Malathion (O, O-Dimethyl Dithiophosphate of Diethyl Mercaptosuccinate)	4.0%
Methoxychlor Technical	5.0%
(equivalent to 4.4% 2, 2-bis (p-methoxyphenyl) - 1, 1, 1-trichloroethane and 0.6% other isomers and reaction products)

TIGER Livestock Dust is a mixture of Malathion and Marlate R for use on Swine, Sheep, Dairy and Beef Cattle.

Malathion is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Not for use or storage in or around the home. Do not treat animals under 1 month of age.

CATTLE: (Beef and Non-lactating)

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To control horn flies, lice and ticks make thorough application to animal working dust into the hair. Repeat every 2 weeks if necessary. Do not treat non-lactating dairy cattle within 2 weeks of freshening.

DAIRY CATTLE: To control horn flies apply 2 heaping tablespoons full (2 oz.) to back and neck of animal. Rub powder into hair. Do not apply within 5 hours of milking or during milking. Repeat every 3 weeks if necessary.

FOR FACE FLY control on Beef Cattle:

To aid in controlling Face Flies, dust the face of cattle thoroughly. Frequent repeated application may be necessary.

SWINE: To control lice apply thoroughly to animals, pens and litter. Repeat in 10 days and thereafter as needed.

SHEEP: To control lice treat animals thoroughly, work dust into wool if not applied at shearing time. Repeat as needed. Do not apply to lactating animals.

CAUTION: Avoid contamination of feed and feeding troughs and water fountains with dusts.
