

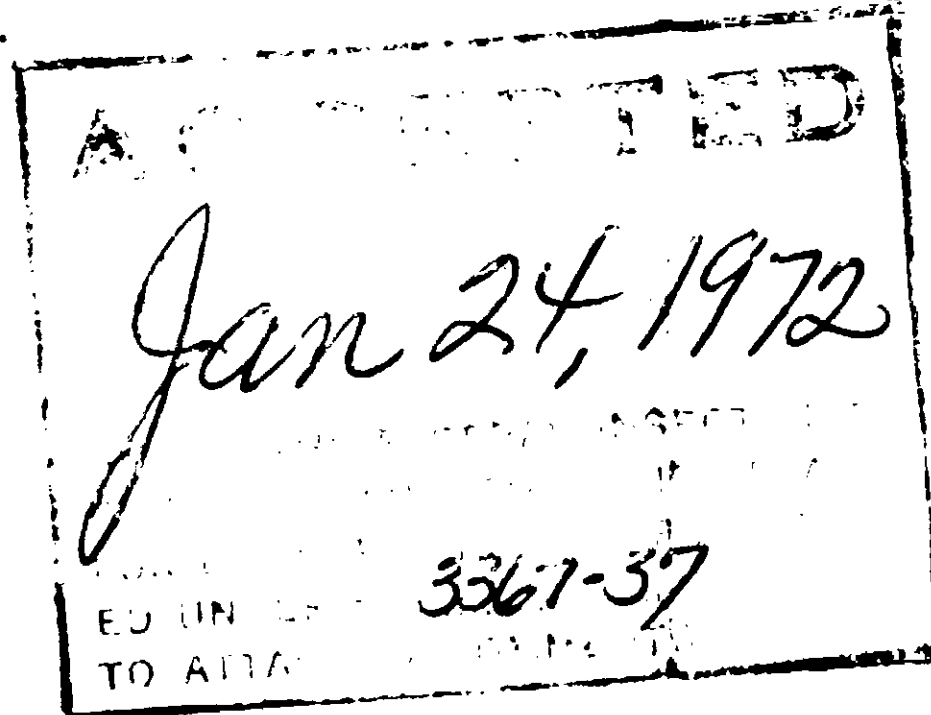
**USAGE:**
