55 Gal. Drums: Do not rinse empty drum. Return to drum reconditioning plant or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place.
Plastic Pails: Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

Sodium Metasilicate, n-alkyl-(50% C11, 10% C12, 10% C16) dimethyl benzyl ammonium chloride
Inert Ingredients 90.10%
Sodium tripolyphosphate, Sodium Sesquicarbonate, Nonylphenoxy polyethoxyethanol, carboxy methylcellulose, optical brighteners
