1. Cleaning and Deodorizing Direction

On Dilution this product forms a rich milky white emulsion.

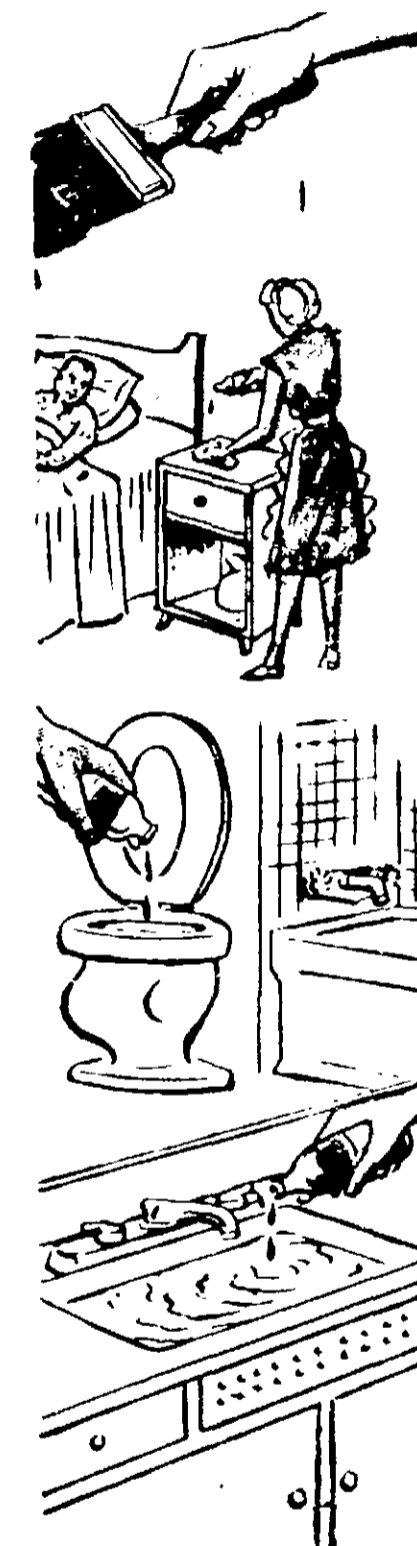
The many cleaning and deodorizing applications of this fine product are exemplified in the illustrations on the border, such as adding it to the washing cycle when machine washing baby diapers and laundry, mopping kitchen floors, cleaning pet shelters, deodorizing garbage cans using the product full strength, removing paint from paintbrushes, deodorizing bedpans in sick rooms, toilets and washbasins, using it full strength. For most cleaning applications 4 oz. in a gallon of water will make a good mopping or scrubbing solution. After applying it diluted or full strength rinse it off thoroughly with plenty of water.

2. Disinfecting: To cleaned surfaces apply a solution of 4 oz. of DELT-O Pine to each gallon of water, and wet surfaces thoroughly by wiping, scrubbing or mopping. Allow ten minutes contact before rinsing.

3. Container Disposal: Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
