PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

SANIBROM 40 BIOCIDE TECHNICAL is not flammable. Avoid contact with strong acids and strong oxidizing agents. Avoid contact with common metals such as aluminum, brass, copper, carbon steel, and stainless steel.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Reformulated or repackaged product must be registered with EPA. The registrant must supply data required for this registration.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Product should be stored at 50° F or above.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: [tank truck] Do not rinse or clean the tank after unloading the contents. Release the tank truck for return to Albemarle Corporation.

[The following statements will be used on labels for stationary tanks]

Refillable container. Refill this container with like pesticide products. Do not reuse this container for any other purpose.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Cleaning the container before final disposal is the responsibility of the person disposing of the container. To clean the container before final disposal, empty the remaining contents from this container into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container about 10 percent full with water. Agitate vigorously or recirculate water with the pump for 2 minutes. Pour or pump rinsate into application equipment or rinsate collection system. Repeat this rinsing procedure two more times.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: [15, 30 and 55 gallon drums] Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Offer for reconditioning if appropriate.

Triple rinse as follows: Empty remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container 1/4 full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: [275-300 gallon tote or IBC] Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Offer for reconditioning if appropriate.

Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents from this container into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container about 10 percent full with water. Agitate vigorously or recirculate water with the pump for 2 minutes. Pour or pump rinsate into application equipment or rinsate collection system. Repeat this rinsing procedure two more times.
