Dear Ms. Oxford:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is conditionally acceptable. In summary, you have revised the First Aid statement in accordance with the recommendations of P.R. Notice 2001-1 and revised the Storage and Disposal instructions. You have also changed the heading "Technical or Chemical Hazards to "Physical or Chemical Hazards".

You must retain the original second, third, and fourth sentences under Storage and Disposal: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is violation of Federal Law. If these wastes can not be disposed of by use in accordance to label instructions, contact your Regional Office of EPA for guidance.

Two copies of the finished labeling must be submitted to the Agency for our files. A stamped copy of your conditionally accepted label is enclosed. If you have any questions regarding this letter, please contact Tom Luminello of my staff at (703) 308-8075.
