Product Chemistry

The Confidential Statements of Formula (CSFs) for the basic formulation dated 10/6/98 are acceptable, are in compliance with PR Notice 91-2 and agree with the label.

Acute Toxicity Profile

This acute toxicity profile is based on the data on file for n-Alkyl (C₁₂ 40%, C₁₄ 50%, C₁₆ 10%) dimethyl benzyl ammonium chloride (069105).

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Label Comments

The Agency inadvertently asked you to delete your "Note to Physician". This was in error. Your label is required to include the following statement: "Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."

Based on the acute toxicity profile, the following sentences must be added to the "Precautionary Statements": "Harmful if absorbed through skin. Harmful if inhaled." Also revise the "First Aid" statement to include the following: "IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention."

Your product only supports the use sites listed on your label "For Use by Manufacturers Only in Formulating Water Treatment Microbiocides". If you wish to add additional sites as per your attachment to the Certification With Respect to Citation of Data Form, you must do so by adding those sites to the label via the submission of an amendment. (Note: This product's active ingredients may not support all of the use sites listed on your attachment.)

The following statements are inappropriate for this product and must be removed from the label. Remove "Formulators are required to add the following label statements to their end use product labels. Do not use water containing residue from this product to irrigate crops used for food or feed."
