BREAKOUT TREATMENT

To remove visible algae accumulations:

1. Brush areas affected with algae accumulations.
2. Add 4 oz. (4 capfuls) of SANIBROM 101 per 10,000 gallons close to the affected areas. For severe accumulations, add 8 oz. per 10,000 gallons.
3. Add 1 lb. of dry chlorine or 1 gallon of liquid chlorine per 10,000 gallons to superchlorinate.

Swimming can be resumed a few hours after treatment.

MAINTENANCE TREATMENT

To prevent visible algae accumulations:

1. Separately, add 4 oz. (4 capfuls) of SANIBROM 101 and 1 lb. of dry chlorine or 1 gallon of liquid chlorine per 10,000 gallons per week.
