

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS DANGER CORROSIVE

Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. May be fatal if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Harmful if inhaled. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

FIRST AID

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. If swallowed: Call a poison controlcenter or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person s.ip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison controlcenter or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poi son control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams. ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA Apply this pesticide only as specified on the label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Albemarte 80451-1P Algicide is effective in controlling the growth of the following types of algae: Chlorellal pyreoldosa (green algae), Phormidium inumdatum (blue-green algae) and Phormidium ritzi.

Ensure all equipment is working properly. Backwash the filter system following manufacturer's directions. Adjust pH between 7.2-7.6. Check for heavy metals and if present, add stain and scale inhibitor to prevent staining of pool surface due to metals. For best results, pool should be free of algae before adding Albemarle 80451-1P Algaecide. The filter should be circulating the pool wat1ar when adding the algicide. Add Albemarle 80451-1P Algicide directly to the pool by pouring around entire outside perimeter of pool. Allow the filter to run for at least six (6) hours after addling the algicide. During this period, swimmers/bathers should not be allowed in the water.

Initial Application: Original filling or when algae are not visible: Add one (1) quart of Albemartte 80451-1P Algicide per 12,500 gallons of pool water (2 ppm active quaternary). Initial Application: If algae are visible: Add four (4) quarts of the algicide per 12,500 gallons of pool water (8 ppm active ingredient) followed by cleaning out of dead, settled algae. Then add one (1) quart of algicide immediately following clean out to control further algae growth.

Maintenance Dose Application: Add one-half (1/2) pint of Albemarle 80451-1P Algicide per 12,500 gallons of pool water every three to five days.

Booster Application: Add two (2) quarts of Albemarle 80451-1P Algicide per 12,500 gallons of pool wat1ar when bather load is heavy or after prolonged rainfall.

Winterization Application: Add one (1) quart of Albemarle 80451-1P Algicide per 12,500 gallons of water (in treating water left in pool). This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposaL STORAGE: Store in original container. Keep from freezing. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL
