DIRECTIONS: Dilute as directed. Do not mix with other cleaners.

- 1. To clean sanitize and deodorize hospital tables, equipment and floors: wash with solution containing 1 oz. Bactoll per gallon of water. To disinfect, apply fresh solution after cleaning.
- 2. (a) To clean and sanitize walls, floors, tables, refrigerators, stoves, sinks, bathroom fixtures, and garbage cans: wash with solution containing ½ ounce Bactoll per gallon of water.

 (b) To clean, disinfect and deodorize walls, floors, tables, refrigerators, stoves, sinks, bathroom fixtures, and garbage cans: wash with solution containing one ounce of Bactoll per gallon of water apply fresh solution after cleaning. Does not affect conductivity of floors.
- (a) To clean and sanitize animal and bird cages, kennels, barns: wash with solution containing ½ ounce of Bactoll per gallon of water.
 (b) To clean, disinfect and deodorize animal and bird cages, kennels, barns: Wash with solution containing one ounce of Bactoll per gallon of water.
- 4. To clean and disinfect combs, brushes, razors, scissors, rubber goods: wipe articles, clean and soak for ten minutes in a solution containing one tablespoonful of Bactoll per quart of water.
- 5. To disinfect sheets, linens, aprons, uniforms and other fabrics: soak in solution containing one ounce Bactoll per gallon of water.
