To kill roaches and waterbugs: Apply in all cracks and crevices in woodwork, underneath sinks, dark places behind pipes, and in all places where roaches and waterbugs infest, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat the operation as often as necessary.

To kill grain weevils, cadelles, grain moths, flour beetles and grain mites (accessible stages): Wet surfaces thoroughly and treat all infested surface areas, insect hiding places and insect runways at the rate of one gallon of Pala Killer on 750 sq. ft. of area equivalent to spraying to point of runoff.
