DIRECTIONS FOR USE

When first filling pool or if no algae is visible add algaecide at rate of 1 gallon per 50,000 gallons of pool water (app. 1 oz. per 300 gallons).

If algae are visible treat pool water by adding algaecide at the rate of 1 gallon per 20,000 gallons (1 oz. per 150 gallons). Next day remove settled material and add a second dose of 1 gallon per 50,000 gallons.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

When first filling pool or if no algae is visible add algaecide at rate of 1 gallon per 50,000 gallons of pool water (app. 1 oz. per 390 gallons).

If algae are visible treat pool water by adding algaecide at the rate of 1 gallon per 20,000 gallons (1 oz. per 150 gallons). Next day remove settled algae and add a second dose if necessary of 1 gallon per 20,000 gallons pool water. Thereafter follow up with maintenance dose of 1 gal. algaecide per 50,000 gallons every 5 to 7 days (1 oz. per 400 gallons).

Add directly to pool or dilute with water and add to pool.
