

Therefore follow up with maintenance dose of 1.3 fluid oz per 10,000 gallons of pool water every 3-5 days or as needed to maintain 2 ppm active. Test kits are available for this use. For booster application add 1.3 fluid oz. per 10,000 gallons after a heavy or prolonged

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rainfall or when there is a heavy bathing load.

The above directions should be followed even when the pool is not in use. If algae growth is noticeable, apply the initial dose.

This product is compatible with many swimming pool chemicals and when used as directed it is not harmful to the metal paint, plastic or tile surfaces of the swimming pool. When used as directed, will help improve the appearance and cleanliness of the swimming pool water.

THIS PRODUCT helps inhibit the growth of unsightly algae. When properly stored for prolonged periods of time, will not lose its effectiveness or strength and requires no special equipment for treating swimming pool water. The correct use-dilution may be added directly to the pool in any spot, or added to the water circulation equipment.
