It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. When first filling pool or when no algae are visible use this product at a rate of 5.2 fluid oz. to each 10,000 gallons of pool water. If algae growth is visible apply the initial dose. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove dead algae. If algae growth is still visible repeat dose as necessary until pool is free of visible algae. Therefore follow up with maintenance dose of 1.3 fluid oz per 10,000 gallons of pool water every 3-5 days or as needed to maintain 2 ppm active. Test kits are available for this use. For booster application add 1.3 fluid oz. per 10,000 gallons after a heavy or prolonged rainfall or when there is a heavy bathing load. The above directions should be followed even when the pool is not in use. If algae growth is noticeable, apply the initial dose. This product is compatible with many swimming pool chemicals and when used as directed it is not harmful to the metal paint, plastic or tile surfaces of the swimming pool.
