This is to acknowledge that your amendment submitted in conjunction with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, to update your label text and revise your Confidential Statement of Formula is acceptable subject to the following conditions.

The Confidential Statement of Formula dated 8/21/98 is in compliance with PR Notice 91-2, it agrees with the label and is acceptable.

- 1) On the second page, remove the "Keep Out of Reach of Children" statement from it's current location and place below the signal word DANGER. Alternatively this statement can be deleted entirely from the second page.
 - 2) Revise the first sentence of the sanitization instructions as follows:

"To sanitize the surfaces of the following pool equipment only in those locations where the surfaces are <u>above the water line</u> (ladders, diving boards, and non-porous pool coping). These surfaces may be sanitized while the pool is full of water. First clean thoroughly with a solution..."

DANGER

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

When first filling pool or when no algae are visible use this product at a rate of 17 fluid oz. to each 5,000 gallone of pool water, it algae growth is visible apply 32 fluid oz, to each 3,500 gal. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove dead algae. It algae is still visible repeat dose as necessary until pool is free of visible algae. Thereafter follow up with a maintenance dose of 17 fluid oz, per 5,000 gal, of pool water every 5-7 days or as needed. Add this product to pool water $\frac{1}{2}$ from of the pool return while filter is on, for best results allow the filter to run for at least 24 hours after adding this product. This product is effective over all normal pool balance values. Bathers should not be in the pool when this product is added and should not re-enter for at least 15 minutes.

The above directions should be followed even when the pool is not in use. Do not use water containing residue from this product to impate crops used for food or feed.

AS A SANITIZER — To sanitize pool surfaces such as ledders, diving boards and non-porous pool coping, above the water line while the pool is full, first clean thoroughly with a solution containing approximately 1 oz. of this product in 1 1/2 gallons of water. Then sanitize desired surfaces with a rinae solution containing 1/2 cunce of this product per 1 1/2 gallons of water. Allow this solution to remain in contact for 10 minutes. The product can then be wiped off with a cloth or rinaed with clear water.

Do not mix this product with other pool chemicals, especially chlorine. Do not re-use container.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS: Store in original containers and place in locked storage area, Keep from freezing. Do not contaminate water, tood, or feed by storage or disposal.
- 2. SPILL OR LEAK PACCEDURES: Small apilla may be mopped up of flushed away with water or absorbed on some absorbent material and incherated.
