PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER. CORROSIVE: Causes irreversible eye and skin burns. Do not get in eyes, or on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. FIRST AID	
IF IN EYES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
IF SWALLOWED	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
IF INHALED	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

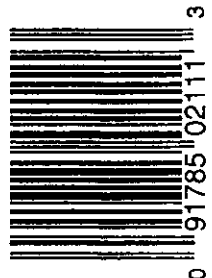
DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

When first filling pool or when no algae are visible use this product at a rate of 17 fluid oz. to each 5,000 gallons of pool water. If algae growth is visible apply 32 fluid oz. to each 3,500 gal. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove dead algae. If algae is still visible repeat dose as necessary until pool is free of visible algae. Thereafter follow up with a maintenance dose of 17 fluid oz. per 5,000 gal. of pool water every 5-7 days or as needed. Add this product to pool water in front of the pool return while filter is on, for best results allow the filter to run for at least 24 hours after adding this product. This product is effective over all normal pool balance values. Bathers should not be in the pool when this product is added and should not re-enter for at least 15 minutes. The above directions should be followed even when the pool is not in use. Do not use water containing residue from this product to irrigate crops used for food or feed.

AS A SANITIZER - To sanitize the surfaces of the following pool equipment only in those locations where the surfaces are above the water line (ladders, diving boards and non-porous pool coping). These surfaces may be sanitized while the pool is full of water. First clean thoroughly with a solution containing approximately 1 oz. of this product in 1 1/2 gallons of water. Then sanitize cleaned surfaces with a rinse solution containing 1/2 ounce of this product per 1 1/2 gallons of water. Allow this solution to remain in contact for 10 minutes. The product can then be wiped off with a cloth or rinsed with clear water. **Do not mix this product with other pool chemicals, especially chlorine. Do not re-use container.**

STORAGE: Store in original containers and place in locked storage area. Keep from freezing. Small spills may be mopped up or flushed away with water or absorbed on some material and incinerated. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse container. Wrap and put in trash.
