

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

DANGER: Highly Irritant. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID): If swallowed, feed breads and drink milk. Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately. For skin: Brush off excess. Wash with plenty of cold water. For eyes: Flush with plenty of cold water. Get medical attention.

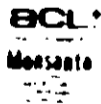

This product is recommended to help keep bacteria under control in swimming pools.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Always use the recommended method of measuring and adding product to a pool. Chlorinate approximately 9000 gallons of water with approximately 8 tablets. Each tablet weighs 2.0 oz. Tablets are completely soluble and do not contribute to scale build up.

DIRECTIONS: Tablets should be added to a swimming pool in a mesh dispenser. Never throw tablets directly into the pool. As standing water is added, add approximately 8 tablets for every 9000 gallons of water. Establish a chlorine residual of 1.0 ppm. Add 1 tablet for every 1000 gallons of water. Add sufficient quantity of tablets to maintain a residual of 1.0 ppm. Tablets should be added to the pool daily. Do not use in hot water. Do not use in water containing other chemicals.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use: Always use in accordance with directions on label for dispersing in swimming pool water. Each tablet weighs approximately 400 mg of active ingredient. There are approximately 37 tablets per 15 lb. package. Each tablet weighs 3.7 grams.

DIRECTIONS: For best results, the chlorinating tablets should be used in conjunction with the water filtering and circulating system. For new pools, add approximately 3 tablets per 1000 gallons of water. For existing pools, add 1 tablet per 1000 gallons of water weekly. For algae control, add 1 tablet per 1000 gallons of water weekly. For bacterial control, add 1 tablet per 1000 gallons of water weekly. For maintenance, add 1 tablet per 1000 gallons of water weekly. For shock treatment, add 3-5 tablets per 1000 gallons of water.

To Calculate Pool Size:
Multiply length by width by average depth to get volume in cubic feet. Divide by 7.48 to get gallons.
