DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.  
Before initiating daily chlorine use, superchlorinate (Shock treat) the pool water by broadcasting across the surface of the pool, 2 ozs. (1/4 cup) of SCORCH II per 4,000 gallons of water. Superchlorinate in the evening when the pool is no longer in use. Check the chlorine residual the following morning with a suitable test kit. If the chlorine residual is above 3.0 p.p.m., refrain from swimming until the residual has decreased.  
During the summer months, when the temperature is below 80°F, superchlorinate every two weeks. During especially hot periods and/or bather loads, superchlorinate weekly.  
For normal pool maintenance, add chlorinating sanitizer according to package instructions to maintain a minimum chlorine residual of between 1.0 and 2.0 p.p.m. at all times.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container in an open area if possible, and flood with large amounts of water. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved landfill area or bury in a safe place.
