This letter acknowledges receipt of your notification submitted under the provisions of FIFRA section 3(c)9 and PR Notice 98-10.

Proposed Notification

- Update Container Disposal Statements per PR Notice 2007-4
- Add Environmental Hazards Statements
- Add panel reference statement

General Comments

Based on a review of the submitted materials, your notification to revise the label with the changes mentioned above is unacceptable for the following reasons:

- 1. Revise the first statement under Environmental Hazards to be in agreement with the ADBAC RED by stating "This pesticide is toxic to fish, aquatic invertebrates, oysters, and shrimp."
- 2. Since your product is intended for residential use only per your November 20, 2001 letter, revise your proposed "Storage and Disposal" statements as follows:

As Agent for N. Jonas & Company Inc. ("Jonas"), I am submitting a Notification under the provisions of PR Notices 1998-10, 2007-1 and 2007-4 to advise the Agency of minor changes to the label for **QLF Algicide** (**EPA Reg. No. 3432-63**).

The label changes are as follows:

- 1) Replace the Environmental Hazards language, which was inadvertently omitted from the last label notification.
- 2) Update the container disposal language in the Storage and Disposal section per the instructions provided in PR Notice 2007-1 and PR Notice 2007-4. Please note that this Jonas product is sold for household/residential use only. Therefore, only the label language for household/residential containers required by these PR Notices is applicable to this product.
- 3) Revise the panel reference statement to read, "See [back] [side] panel for additional precautionary statements and First Aid."

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: This Algicide is cationic. Do not mix with soap or anionic materials. Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SWIMMING POOLS

INITIAL DOSE: Add 5 1/4 fluid ounces of product to 10,000 gallons of pool water. MAINTENANCE DOSE: Add 1 1/4 fluid ounces of product to 10,000 gallons of pool water.

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If pool has a visible algae growth, treat with initial dose. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove algae debris. If visible algae are still present or re-appear, repeat this treatment procedure as necessary. When pool is free of visible algae, use the recommended maintenance dose.

Maintenance dose should be added weekly. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.

Maintenance dose should be added after a heavy or prolonged rainfall.

If make-up water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 1/2 fluid ounce of product for each 1000 gallons of fresh make-up water added.

When swimming season is over, add maintenance dose prior to closing pool. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

When this product is used as directed, it is effective against Chlorella pyrenoidosa (green algae), Phormidium luridum (black algae), Lyngbya versicolor (blue-green algae), and Pleurochloris meiringensis (mustard algae), and other swimming pool algae and slime producing microorganisms.

For persistent algae or slime producing microorganisms growth, add 5-7 1/2 ounces of this product into the skimmer with the filter pump running. After one minute, shut off the pump and allow the system to remain off over night. The following day, re-start the filter pump and add 5-7 1/2 ounces of this product to the pool. Run the filter continuously for 24-48 hours, brushing the sides and bottom of the pool frequently.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate food or feed by storage; disposal, or cleaning of equipment.

STORAGE: Keep container closed and in a cool place when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spills with clear water. Keep pesticides out of reach of children and stored away from food.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling if available. If Empty. Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If Partly Filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
