Pre-dissolve the recommended dose of this product for all other pools, VINYL, FIBERGLASS, PAINTED AND ALL COLORED PLASTER POOLS. To pre-dissolve, add one pound of QUICK SHOCK CHLORINATOR to 2-3 gallons of water in a clean bucket. REMEMBER that the shock should be added to the water. NEVER add water to dry product. Use 1 to 2 pounds to treat each 7,500 gallons of water. Do not mix more than one pound at a time and never add any other chemicals or products to the solution in this bucket.
