FIRST AID	
If In Eyes:	Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If On Skin Or Clothing:	Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Avoid mixing Winter Powder Algaecide with other chemicals as dangerous reactions may occur.

Add Winter Powder Algaecide only to a clean and algae free pool. For maximum results vacuum or remove by hand any debris and super chlorinate pool before adding Winter Powder Algaecide.

Use 16 ounces (1 lb.) of Winter Powder Algaecide for every 10,000 gallons to be treated. Start with a clean, empty bucket. Put at least 2 gallons of water in the bucket and then add 1 lb. of Winter Powder Algaecide.

Stir thoroughly to dissolve all particles. Pour off liquid and, if necessary, dilute any remaining solids with additional water. Pour 1) solution into the skimmer making sure that O pump is activated, skimmer contains no other D material, and water flows freely into skimmer. 9 For optimal distribution, allow filter to run for several hours. If filtration system is not in operation, pour solution into pool while moving around the perimeter. Disburse solution as extensively as possible. When winterizing is complete, cover pool.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.
