As Agent for N. Jonas & Company Inc. ("Jonas"), I am submitting a Notification under the provisions of PR Notices 1998-10, 2007-1 and 2007-4 to advise the Agency of minor changes to the label for **Algicil 2+2 (EPA Reg. No. 3432-74)**.

The label changes are as follows:

1) Replace the Environmental Hazards language, which was inadvertently omitted from the last label notification.

2) Update the container disposal language in the Storage and Disposal section per the instructions provided in PR Notice 2007-1 and PR Notice 2007-4. Please note that this Jonas product is sold for household/residential use only. Therefore, only the label language for household/residential containers required by these PR Notices is applicable to this product.

Please find enclosed the following documents to support the notification for Algicil 2+2:

1) Pesticide Application Form; and,

2) Three (3) copies of the revised product label with the changes highlighted.

- 2. INITIAL TREATMENT FOR POOLS WITH VISIBLE ESTABLISHED ALGAE: Use 16 to 24 oz. of Algicil 2+2 for every 10,000 gallons of water. Remove dead, settled algae by vacuuming.
- **3. BLACK ALGAE CONTROL:** Apply 16 fluid oz. of Algicil 2+2 for every 10,000 gallons of water when algae first appears. Brush spots daily to remove dead algae. Vacuum out settled algae.
- **4. TO MAINTAIN POOLS FREE OF VISIBLE ALGAE GROWTH:** Use 4 to 8 oz. of Algicil 2+2 for every 10,000 gallons of water weekly.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep container closed and in a cool place when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spills with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this pesticide may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

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#### **HOW TO DETERMINE POOL CAPACITY (IN U.S. GALLONS)**

For Rectangular Pools: average depth x length x width (all in feet) x 7.5 = gallons.

For Round Pools: Diameter of pool x diameter of pool x average depth (all in feet) x 5.9 = gallons.
