## Dear Kresti Lyddon:

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Polixetonium Chloride Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. Pursuant to 40 CFR 156.10(a)(6) you must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

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Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency. See FIFRA section 2(p)(2). If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process, FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(B). Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6. **DIRECTIONS USE:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Users are recommended to wear waterproof or chemical-resistant gloves when applying this product to pools. Suggested glove types include butyl and nitrile.

- **1. INITIAL TREATMENT FOR THE PREVENTION OF ALGAE GROWTH IN CLEAR POOL WATER:** Use 8 to 12 oz. of Algicil 2+2 for every 10,000 gallons of water.
- **2. INITIAL TREATMENT FOR POOLS WITH VISIBLE ESTABLISHED ALGAE:** Use 16 to 24 oz. of Algicil 2+2 for every 10,000 gallons of water. Remove dead, settled algae by vacuuming.
- **3. BLACK ALGAE CONTROL:** Apply 16 fluid oz. of Algicil 2+2 for every 10,000 gallons of water when algae first appears. Brush spots daily to remove dead algae. Vacuum out settled algae.
- **4. TO MAINTAIN POOLS FREE OF VISIBLE ALGAE GROWTH:** Use 4 to 8 oz. of Algicil 2+2 for every 10,000 gallons of water weekly.

Before draining a treated pool, contact your local sanitary sewer and storm drain authorities and follow their discharge instructions. Do not discharge treated pool water to any location that flows to a gutter or storm drain or natural water body unless discharge is allowed by state and local authorities.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

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## **HOW TO DETERMINE POOL CAPACITY (IN U.S. GALLONS)**

For Rectangular Pools: average depth x length x width (all in feet) x 7.5 = gallons.

For Round Pools: Diameter of pool x diameter of pool x average depth (all in feet) x 5.9 = gallons.
