As Agent for N. Jonas & Company Inc. ("Jonas"), I am submitting a Notification under the provisions of PR Notices 1998-10, 2007-1 and 2007-4 to advise the Agency of minor changes to the label for **Poly 20 Algaecide (EPA Reg. No. 3432-80)**.

The label changes are as follows:

- 1) Replace the Environmental Hazards language, which was inadvertently omitted from the last label notification.
- 2) Update the container disposal language in the Storage and Disposal section per the instructions provided in PR Notice 2007-1 and PR Notice 2007-4. Please note that this Jonas product is sold for household/residential use only. Therefore, only the label language for household/residential containers required by these PR Notices is applicable to this product.

- 2) Three (3) copies of the revised product label with the changes highlighted.

Poly 20 Algaecide is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness, swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools and hot tubs containing heavy algae growth should be cleaned prior to using **Poly 20 Algaecide**.

For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 37 to 56 fluid ounces of **Poly 20 Algaecide** per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 20 to 37 fluid ounces of **Poly 20 Algaecide** per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 7 to 13 ounces of **Poly 20 Algaecide** per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools and hot tubs having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 4 to 6 fluid ounces of **Poly 20 Algaecide** per 1,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled spas, whirlpools and hot tubs, add initially 2 to 4 fluid ounces of **Poly 20 Algaecide** per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 to 2 ounces of **Poly 20 Algaecide** per 1,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Poly 20 Algaecide will prevent growth of most algae during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. For pools which have been properly treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add 20 to 32 fluid ounces of Poly 20 Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. If, at the end of the swimming season pools have some visible algae growth, add 37 to 57 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of Poly 20 Algaecide be made throughout the water and the pool for maximum effectiveness. If the pool is not covered, it may be necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times during the season.

Poly 20 Algaecide is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Poly 20 Algaecide can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix Poly 20 Algaecide with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep container closed and in a cool place when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spills with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

HOW TO DETERMINE POOL CAPACITY (IN U.S. GALLONS)

For Rectangular Pools: average depth x length x width (all in feet) $\times 7.5 = \text{gallons}$.

For Round Pools: Diameter of pool x diameter of pool x average depth (all in feet) x 5.9 = gallons.
