## Dear Kresti Lyddon:

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Polixetonium Chloride Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. Pursuant to 40 CFR 156.10(a)(6) you must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6. ### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:** CAUTION. Harmful if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Wear chemical resistant gloves. Suggested glove types include Butyl and Nitrile. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Before draining a treated pool, contact your local sanitary sewer and storm drain authorities and follow their discharge instructions. Do not discharge treated pool water to any location that flows to a gutter or storm drain or natural water body unless discharge is allowed by state and local authorities.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children or pets, either directly or through drift.

**Poly 20 Algaecide** is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness, swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools and hot tubs containing heavy algae growth should be cleaned prior to using **Poly 20 Algaecide**.

For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 37 to 56 fluid ounces of **Poly 20 Algaecide** per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 20 to 37 fluid ounces of **Poly 20 Algaecide** per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 7 to 13 ounces of **Poly 20 Algaecide** per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools and hot tubs having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 4 to 6 fluid ounces of **Poly 20 Algaecide** per 1,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled spas, whirlpools and hot tubs, add initially 2 to 4 fluid ounces of **Poly 20 Algaecide** per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 to 2 ounces of **Poly 20 Algaecide** per 1,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

**Poly 20 Algaecide** will prevent growth of most algae during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. For pools which have been properly treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add 20 to 32 fluid ounces of **Poly 20 Algaecide** per 10,000 gallons of water. If, at the end of the swimming season pools have some visible algae growth, add 37 to 57 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of **Poly 20 Algaecide** be made throughout the water and the pool for maximum effectiveness. If the pool is not covered, it may be necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times during the season.

**Poly 20 Algaecide** is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. **Poly 20 Algaecide** can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix **Poly 20 Algaecide** with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Keep container closed and in a cool place when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spills with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this pesticide may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

### **HOW TO DETERMINE POOL CAPACITY (IN U.S. GALLONS)**

For Rectangular Pools: average depth x length x width (all in feet) x 7.5 = gallons. For Round Pools: Diameter of pool x diameter of pool x average depth (all in feet) x 5.9 = gallons
