DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Avoid mixing Winter Powder Algaecide with other chemicals as dangerous reactions may occur.

Add Winter Powder Algaecide only to a clean and algae free pool. For maximum results vacuum or remove by hand any debris and super chlorinate pool before adding Winter Powder Algaecide.

Use 16 ounces (1 lb.) of Winter Powder Algaecide for every 10,000 gallons to be treated. Do not exceed 0.75 ppm metallic copper. Start with a clean, empty bucket. Put at least 2 gallons of water in the bucket and then add 1 lb. of Winter Powder Algaecide.

Stir thoroughly to dissolve all particles. Pour off liquid and, if necessary, dilute any remaining solids with additional water. Pour solution into the skimmer making sure that pump is activated, skimmer contains no other material, and water flows freely into skimmer. For optimal distribution, allow filter to run for several hours. If filtration system is not in operation, pour solution into pool while moving around the perimeter. Disburse solution as extensively as possible. When winterizing is complete, cover pool.

Before draining a treated pool, contact your sanitary sewer and storm drain authorities and follow their discharge instructions. Do not discharge treated pool water to any

location that flows to a gutter, storm drain or natural water body unless discharge is allowed by state and local authorities.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling if available. **If Empty:** Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If Partly Filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
