

MANEB-SULFUR

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Maneb (Manganese ethylenebisdithiocarbamate) 6.0%
(Manganese equivalent as metallic 1.23%)
Sulfur 46.5%

INERT INGREDIENTS. 47.5%

Caution: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

May irritate eyes, nose, throat and skin. May be harmful if inhaled or swallowed. Avoid breathing of dust. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. In case of contact, flush skin or eyes with plenty of water, for eyes, get medical attention.

IMPORTANT: Keep away from fire or sparks. Never allow Maneb to become wet during storage. This may lead to certain chemical changes which will reduce effectiveness of Maneb as a fungicide and create vapors which may be flammable. Keep container closed when not in use. Use dust mixture as soon as possible after preparation.

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes.

Dispose of wastes by burying at least 18 inches deep in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Do not reuse container, bury with wastes. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from area treated.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Read the entire label and conditions of sale, including the Warranty, before using Maneb Sulfur. Apply dust when diseases first appear and repeat at intervals as required to upper and lower leaf surfaces. Observe day intervals between last application and harvest. Cantaloupe; anthracnose, cercospora leaf spot, down mildew, gummy stem blight. Use 30 lbs. per acre. Begin at late bunching when vines begin to run or when disease first appears. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals. Do not apply within 5 days of harvest. Lettuce (Head); downy mildew. Use 30-40 lbs. per acre. Begin when disease appears. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals. Do not apply within 10 days of harvest. Remove residues from head lettuce by stripping and trimming. Potatoes; early and late blight, Use 30 lbs. per acre. Begin when plants are 2 to 6 inches high. Repeat at 5 to 10 day intervals, more often under severe late blight conditions. No time limitations.
