CAUTION

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label. Cover or incorporate spilled treated seed pieces.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Do not store under conditions which might adversely affect the container or its ability to function properly. Such conditions include, but are not limited to, positioning of the container in storage, storage temperature, potential for crushing or damage due to stacking, and penetration of moisture.

STORAGE: Store in original container only. Store in cool, dry place. Reduce stacking height where local conditions, such as humidity or pallet overhang, can affect package strength. Personnel should use clothing and equipment consistent with good pesticide handling.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. If on skin, wash immediately with soap and water.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Schaff Potato Seed Treater is a special fungicidal dust formulation for application on whole or cut potato tubers. Use of this product will aid in controlling fusarium seed piece decay and tuber-borne common scab but is ineffective against tuber- and soil-borne bacterial diseases. This pesticide will not control bacterial diseases or other diseases not claimed on this label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of the Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not use this product at higher than recommended rate.

For the suppression of potato seed piece decay caused by Fusarium decay, use 1 pound Schaff potato Seed Treater per 100 pounds of cut or whole seed pieces. Apply so that the cut or whole seed pieces are thoroughly covered with dust by the use of a convenient container or dust attachment over the belt. Rotating drum dusters generally provide better coverage than shaker treaters.

Thoroughly clean and sanitize cutting machines, knives, trays, tables, barrels, equipment, trucks and platters before cutting and planting seed pieces. If seed potatoes have not sprouted, subject them to temperatures of 60° to 65° F for about 10 to 15 days before handling. Treat the warmed seed pieces immediately after they are cut. The cut and treated seed piece should be held for a week or more at cool temperature and high relative humidity, however they may be planted immediately. This holding period promotes suberization and allows the cut surfaces to heal.

Do not use treated seed piece for food, feed or fodder.
