be given two heavy coats by brush (allow 24 hours between applications) at a rate of 100-150 sq. ft. per gallon. Clean all tools after using.

Note: Creosote may not be used on wood that is intended for interior use except for those support structures (e.g., foundation timbers, pole supports and the bottom six inches of stall skirtboards) which are in contact with the soil in barns, stables and similar sites.

Creosote may not be used on wood in a manner which may result in direct exposure to domestic animals or livestock or in the contamination of food, feed, or drinking and irrigation water (e.g., irrigation flumes, watering troughs, feed lot bins and vegetable stakes).
