Subject: Amendment of Products Containing Lindane
Eagles 7 Mange Treatment
EPA Registration No. 3487-18
Your Application Dated December 16, 1985

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below at the next label printing.

It has come to our attention that the subject application was not reviewed when initially submitted and thus we are providing you with our comments now. We regret any inconvenience this may have caused.

1. The use directions are written for use by kennels/veterinarians. The claims sarcoptic mange and ear mites are also considered drug claims in addition to pesticide claims. Thus add to the front panel, **For Veterinary and Kennel Use.**
2. The active ingredient must be identified as "Lindane (gamma isomer of benzene hexachloride)."
3. Update the Environmental Hazards statements as follows:

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate when disposing of equipment washwaters.
4. Revise the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animal statements as follows:

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Avoid prolonged and repeated applications.

- 5. Add "long sleeved shirt, long pants" to the applicator protective clothing statement.
- 6. Change the statement "Do not use on cats or puppies under 3 months of age or nursing bitches." to read "Do not use on Cats. Do not use on puppies under 3 months of age or nursing bitches."

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS - HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Avoid prolonged or repeated applications. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Applicators must wear the following protective clothing during the treatment process: elbow-length, waterproof gloves, a water proof apron, and unlined, water proof boots.

If physical condition of animal is poor, treatment should first be applied only to a small portion of the body to determine tolerance. **DO NOT USE ON CATS OR PUPPIES UNDER 3 MONTHS OF AGE OR NURSING BITCHES.** Do not allow children to handle or apply this pesticide product. For treatment only of mites. Treatment of other pests is prohibited.

Apply onto and around the infested areas and into ears. Repeat treatment every 6 to 7 days as required. If condition is generalized, treat one-third to one-half the body 1 day and finish within the next 1 or 2 days. Long-haired dogs should be clipped, bathed, and aired before starting treatment. To prevent reinfestation, observe strict sanitary conditions in the kennel, bedding, etc. Disinfect and keep infested areas clean. If no improvement is noted in 10 days, consult a veterinarian.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Avoid contamination of ponds, lakes or streams. This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

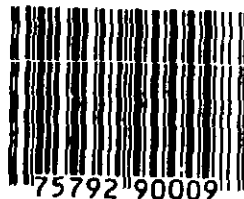
SYMPTOMS OF POISONING: Dizziness, headache, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, tremors, weakness, convulsions, dyspnea, cyanosis, circulatory collapse. Topical use may cause local sensitivity reactions.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT, if swallowed:—Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING.** Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If inhaled:—Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. If on skin:—Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. If in eyes:—Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.
