Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Make the revisions specified below before you print the final labeling for this product.

1. Delete "KILLS RATS MICE" from the front and back panels, as it is already preceded on these panels by "KILLS NORWAY Rats ROOF Rats HOUSE Mice".
2. Add "TOTAL" on the same line as "100.000%" in the ingredients statement on both the front and back panels.
3. The heading "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" should not be run together with the subheading "HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS". Additionally, leave at least one blank line between the "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" heading and the paragraph immediately preceding it and/or

increase the type size of the heading to be comparable to that for "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL".

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

RATS. Apply 4 to 18 oz. of bait per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days.
MOUSE. Apply 1/4 to 1/2 oz. (12 equal placements) of bait at 8- to 12-foot intervals. Larger placements up to 2 oz. may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days. Replace contaminated or soiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all bait wastes and remove bait properly to prevent reinfestation, and sources of rodent food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and re-bait as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE. Store in original container in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets. **DISPOSAL.** Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDOUS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Keep away from humans, domestic animals and pets. If swallowed, the material may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. A violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ THIS LABEL: Read the entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets, or other nontarget animals to roach baits. To help to prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and nontarget wildlife or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. Bait can be shaken from stations when they are filled and must be secured to otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hopped livestock, rodents, birds or other potentially destructive animals or in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Openings of product container and unused, opened and unconsumed bait as specified on the label.

USE INSTRUCTIONS

For control of NORWAY RAT, ROOF RAT and HOUSE MICE in and around homes, industrial buildings and other non-mass structures. Do not place bait in areas where there is a probability of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Do not broadcast bait.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS

Determine areas where rats or mice are most likely to find and consume the bait. Generally these are along walls by grouted openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls or in locations where rodents or other signs have been seen. Protect bait from sun or snow. Remove all such alternative food as possible.
