### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **READ THIS LABEL:** Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions. **IMPORTANT:** Do not expose children, pets, or other nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in a location out of reach of children and pets.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. Bait stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by tampering for years to come, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching and bait compartments and obtaining bait; if bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hoofed livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product containers and unused, spoiled and uncontained bait as specified on this label.

**USE RESTRICTIONS:** For control of Norway RATS, Roof RATS and House MICE in and around homes, industrial buildings and similar man-made structures. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Do not broadcast bait.

**SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS:** Determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in basements and porches of places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Protect bait from rain or snow. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:**  
**RATS:** Apply 4 to 16 oz. of bait per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days or until signs of rat activity cease.

**MICE:** Apply 1/4 to 1/2 oz. (1-2 level teaspoons) of bait at 8-12 foot intervals. Larger placements (up to 2 oz.) may be needed at points of extremely high mouse activity. Space placements at intervals of 8-12 feet. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 15 days or until signs of mouse activity cease.

**RATS/MICE:** Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and properly dispose of all food animals and remove bait to prevent reinfestation; limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatments. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish as needed.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Store in original container in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.  
**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.

#### HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
