3. You may replace the paragraph under "Physical or Chemical Hazards" with that approved for your last accepted label dated February 6, 1981 since the Agency has rescinded PR Notice 87-8, which required the current statements.

Your Confidential Statement of Formula, submitted November 13, 1987, identified Shell Chemical Company under EPA Registration No. 201-125 as your source of technical DDVP. EPA Registration No. 201-125 is no longer registered. Please identify the correct source of DDVP in this product.

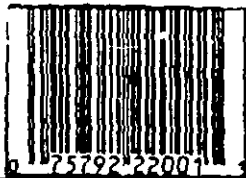
