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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **IMPORTANT:** Read the entire Directions for Use and Precautions before using this product. **EAGLES-7 FIRE ANT DESTROYER** is a ready to use insecticide which exhibits effective long lasting control against fire ants when used according to label directions.

IMPORTED FIRE ANT MOUND TREATMENT:

DO NOT DISTURB THE MOUND PRIOR TO APPLICATION and **DO NOT WATER IN.** Evenly apply **EAGLES-7 FIRE ANT DESTROYER** to adequately cover each mound and around the perimeter (extending 18" from the outer edge of the mound). A second treatment may be necessary if complete control is not obtained. If possible, treat all colonies in the vicinity. Apply when temperatures are between 65 F and 80 F mornings and evenings. Allow 3 to 4 days for maximum control. Then repeat as necessary. Applications during prolonged hot or dry conditions may be less effective.

PERIMETER TREATMENT:

Use **EAGLES-7 FIRE ANT DESTROYER** as a residual treatment for control of fire ants. To prevent the invasion of buildings and structures by these pests, apply thoroughly and uniformly to the foundation and crawl spaces where nests are active and may find entrance.
